

Notes from PCRTA Board Meeting 10/10/17

Harold called the meeting to order at 3:10, with 7 board members in attendance: Harold Niehaus, Bob Fox, Paul Ellison, Darrell Meeks, Nancy Wright, Judy Looker, and Sharon Norman. Secretary's report from the September 12 meeting was read and corrected then approved. Treasurer's report was presented by Darrell and approved. Sharon stated invitations to meetings and summaries are being sent to local newspapers. Several members said they had noticed PCRTA news in the papers. Also, three cards had been sent to members: Larry Russell had surgery, Larry Looker has leukemia, and Dona Mowry had broken her foot. Bob asked that get well/cheer cards be sent to Diana Phineas and Dale Spitler.
